AMENDMENT TO SPECIAL SHELLFISH PERMIT NO. 176532

TYPE CONTAMINATED TRANSPLANT

DATE OF AMENDMENT MAY 17, 2021

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Acting under authority of Paragraphs 2 and 3, Section 17; Sections 69, 75, 80 and 83, Chapter 130 M.G.L., permit No. 176532 is hereby amended to allow:

BOARD OF SELECTMEN
TOWN HALL
WELLFLEET, MA 02667

to take, possess and transplant seed and adult shellfish (QUAHOGS)

from TO THE AREA AS STATED IN THE ORIGINAL PERMIT AND THE AREA

to THE AREAS AS STATED IN THE ORIGINAL PERMIT

subject to the following conditions:

1. The dates of the transplant shall remain May 11, 2021 to May 31, 2021 at which time all relaying shall cease.
2. This permit shall be **amended** to allow 600 bushels of quahogs.
3. This permit shall expire DECEMBER 31, 2021 unless sooner revoked for cause.
4. A record of the shellfish transplanted shall be kept and a copy sent to this office AT THE TERMINATION OF THE TRANSPLANT!
